The Town of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea is hereby giving notice that it intends to apply for about \$30,000 in Community Development Block Grant funding for the 47th Program Year (October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022) available from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Broward County Community Development Department for:

* **Senior Center Activities and operations** The funds will be used to address the recreational, social and educational needs of the residents of the Town Of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea. These activities include computer, yoga, bridge, dancing, chess, water colors classes and meditation sessions.
